# **Crochet Pumpkin Keychain Pattern**

This pattern will guide you through creating a charming pumpkin keychain using basic crochet stitches. You can easily customize the size and color combinations make it your own!

Skill Level: Beginner

Finished Size: Approximately 3 inches tall and 2.5 inches wide (adjusting rows will change these measurements).

Materials:

- Cotton yarn (your choice of pumpkin color)
- Brown or green cotton yarn (for the stem)
- 2.5mm crochet hook
- Fiberfill stuffing
- 1 keychain clip
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

# Abbreviations (US Terms):

- **ch** = chain
- HDC = half double crochet
- sc = single crochet
- **sl st** = slip stitch
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- magic ring = adjustable ring to start crochet in the round

# Notes:

- Using an even number of rows for the body helps create defined "nodes" on the pumpkin.
- The initial chain determines the pumpkin's height, and the number of rows determines its width.
- This pattern offers suggestions for adjusting rows to shape the pumpkin.

# Pumpkin Body:

#### Round 1:

- 1. Make a slip knot and Ch 18.
- 2. Skip the first 2 Ch, then Hdc in the next Ch and across the remaining Chs (16 hdc).
- 3. Ch 2, turn.

# Round 2:

- 1. Hdc in the first st, then Hdc across the row (16 hdc).
- 2. Ch 2, turn.

# Rounds 3-18:

1. Repeat Round 2 for a total of 18 rows.

#### Joining the Pumpkin:

- 1. Fold the rectangular piece in half lengthwise, aligning the first and last row.
- 2. Using your yarn needle and a contrasting color, stitch the two ends together with sl st stitches, working behind the back loops of the hdc stitches.
- 3. Leave a small opening for stuffing.

# Stuffing the Pumpkin:

- 1. Carefully turn the pumpkin right-side out.
- 2. Gently stuff with fiberfill.
- 3. Close the remaining opening with sl st stitches.

# **Creating the Nodes:**

- 1. At the top of each pumpkin, gently gather stitches between the rows with your fingers.
- 2. This creates the bumpy, ridge effect of a pumpkin.

#### **Pumpkin Stem:**

- 1. Make a magic ring.
- 2. 8 Sc in the magic ring.
- 3. SI st to the first Sc.
- 4. Ch 1, 2 Sc in the next st.
- 5. 1 Sc in the next st.
- 6. Ch 1, 2 Sc in the next st.
- 7. Continue alternating 1 Sc, then Ch 1, 2 Sc around until the end of the row (12 total sc).
- 8. SI st to the first st of the round.
- 9. Ch 1, fasten off and weave in the ends.

#### Attaching the Stem:

1. Attach the stem to the top of the pumpkin with a yarn needle and your stem color yarn.

#### Attaching the Keychain Clip:

1. Attach the keychain clip to the top of your pumpkin using your yarn needle and yarn.

#### **Customizing Your Pumpkin:**

#### Changing Pumpkin Size:

- **Taller Pumpkin:** Increase the starting chain length and the total number of rows. (For instance, start with 20 chains and work 20 rows for a taller pumpkin.)
- Wider Pumpkin: Add more hdc stitches each row.
- Shorter Pumpkin: Decrease the number of rows.

#### Varying Node Counts:

- To have fewer nodes, make a rectangle that's a multiple of 4 rows (e.g., 12, 16, 20).
- To have more nodes, make a rectangle that has more rows (but still an even number).

# **Color Variations:**

- Use a different color for the pumpkin body, for example, white, cream, or a variegated yarn.
- Choose various shades of green or brown for the stem.

# Tips:

- Use a stitch marker to keep track of your rounds if you get lost!
- You can use different types of yarn for a unique texture.
- Get creative with different stem colors and sizes.
