Crochet Pumpkin Pattern: Medium Size

Alright, you want a pumpkin pattern? Get your crochet hooks ready! Here's how to make your own adorable crocheted pumpkins, perfect for fall decorating or gifting. This pattern uses US crochet terms.

Materials:

- Worsted weight yarn (approximately 70 yards orange for the medium pumpkin, adjust yardage for different sizes)
- Brown worsted weight yarn (small amount for stem)
- 5mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers (optional, but helpful!)
- Polyfill stuffing

Abbreviations (US Terms):

- MR: Magic Ring
- Ch: Chain
- HDC: Half Double Crochet
- SC: Single Crochet
- BLO: Back Loop Only
- SI st: Slip Stitch
- Inc: Increase (2 SC in one stitch)
- Dec: Decrease (Single Crochet 2 stitches together)

Pattern Notes:

- This pattern is worked in continuous rounds (spirals). Do not join at the end of each round unless instructed. Use a stitch marker or piece of yarn to keep track of the beginning of each round.
- You can adjust the size of your pumpkin by crocheting more or fewer rounds. For a smaller pumpkin, work fewer rounds in the body. For a larger pumpkin, add more rounds before beginning the decreases.

Pumpkin Body (Orange):

- Round 1: 8 sc in a magic circle. (8 stitches)
- Round 2: 2 sc in each stitch around. (16 stitches)
- **Round 3:** 2 sc in next stitch, 1 sc in next stitch. Repeat around. (24 stitches)
- Round 4: 2 sc in next stitch, 1 sc in each of next 2 stitches. Repeat around. (32 stitches)
- **Round 5:** 2 sc in next stitch, 1 sc in each of next 3 stitches. Repeat around. (40 stitches)
- Round 6: 2 sc in next stitch, 1 sc in each of next 4 stitches. Repeat around. (48 stitches)
- Rounds 7-14: 1 sc in each stitch around. (48 stitches)

Shaping the Pumpkin: Now we start decreasing make that pumpkin shape!

Round 15: *Sc2tog, 1 sc in each of next 4 stitches.* Repeat around. (40 stitches) **Round 16:** *Sc2tog, 1 sc in each of next 3 stitches.* Repeat around. (32 stitches) **Round 17:** *Sc2tog, 1 sc in each of next 2 stitches.* Repeat around. (24 stitches)

Round 18: Sc2tog, 1 sc in next stitch. Repeat around. (16 stitches)

Finishing the Pumpkin:

Round 19: Sc2tog around. (8 stitches) **Round 20:** Sc2tog around. (4 stitches)

SI st the last stitch and fasten off, leaving a long tail for shaping.

Shaping:

- 1. Thread your yarn needle with the long tail.
- 2. Find the natural ridges created by the decrease rounds.
- 3. Insert the needle through a stitch on Round 2 (or whichever round creates the desired depth for your ridges) and bring it out through the center top of the pumpkin.
- 4. Pull yarn snugly create a segment. Tie a knot on the inside the pumpkin secure the segment.
- 5. Repeat, creating 5 more segments evenly spaced around the pumpkin.
- 6. Weave in any remaining tail ends.

Pumpkin Stem (Brown):

Round 1: 6 sc in a magic circle. (6 stitches)

Rounds 2-4: 1 sc in each stitch around. (6 stitches)

Round 5: Working in front loops only: 2 sc in next stitch, sc in next stitch. Repeat around. (9 stitches) SI st the last stitch and fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Assembly:

- 1. Position the stem in the center top of the pumpkin.
- 2. Using the long tail and yarn needle, sew the stem the pumpkin, going through the front loops of the last round of the stem. Secure with a knot inside the stem and weave in any remaining ends.
