Crochet Daisy Cardigan Pattern

Skill Level: Intermediate

Materials:

- **Yarn:** Medium weight (worsted) acrylic yarn. I recommend Örenbayan Favori (color code 001 for the original design), or any similar substitute. You'll need approximately 6 skeins (2 packs) or around 700-800 yards total. Feel free to experiment with different colors for the main cardigan and the daisies!
- Crochet Hook: 4mm (US size G/6)
- Stitch Markers: At least 4
- Scissors
- Yarn Needle

Sizing:

This pattern is designed for a size small/medium. You can easily adjust the size by increasing or decreasing the number of stitches in each row.

Abbreviations:

- ch chain
- sc single crochet
- sl st slip stitch
- inc increase (2 sc in the same stitch)
- dec decrease (sc2tog)
- st(s) stitch(es)
- rep repeat

Gauge:

10 sc and 12 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) in single crochet. Check your gauge before beginning the project.

Back Panel:

- 1. Ribbing: Ch 10.
 - **Row 1:** Sc in the second ch from the hook and in each ch across. Turn (10 sc).
 - **Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in the first st and in each st across. Turn (10 sc).
 - Rep Rows 1 and 2 until you have a ribbing section approximately 3 inches (7.5 cm) long.

2. Body:

- Row 1: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (10 sc).
- **Row 2:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (10 sc).
- **Row 3:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 4 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 4 sts.* (12 sc).
- **Row 4:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (12 sc).
- **Row 5:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 5 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 5 sts.* (14 sc).
- **Row 6:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (14 sc).

- **Row 7:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 6 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 6 sts.* (16 sc).
- Row 8: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (16 sc).
- **Row 9:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 7 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 7 sts.* (18 sc).
- Row 10: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (18 sc).
- **Row 11:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 8 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 8 sts.* (20 sc).
- Row 12: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (20 sc).
- **Row 13:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 9 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 9 sts.* (22 sc).
- **Row 14:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (22 sc).
- **Row 15:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 10 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 10 sts.* (24 sc).
- **Row 16:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (24 sc).
- **Row 17:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 11 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 11 sts.* (26 sc).
- **Row 18:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (26 sc).
- **Row 19:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 12 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 12 sts.* (28 sc).
- **Row 20:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (28 sc).
- **Row 21:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 13 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 13 sts.* (30 sc).
- **Row 22:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (30 sc).
- **Row 23:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 14 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 14 sts.* (32 sc).
- **Row 24:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (32 sc).
- **Row 25:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 15 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 15 sts.* (34 sc).
- **Row 26:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (34 sc).
- **Row 27:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 16 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 16 sts.* (36 sc).
- **Row 28:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (36 sc).
- **Row 29:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 17 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 17 sts.* (38 sc).
- **Row 30:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (38 sc).
- **Row 31:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 18 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 18 sts.* (40 sc).
- **Row 32:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (40 sc).

- **Row 33:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 19 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 19 sts.* (42 sc).
- Row 34: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (42 sc).
- **Row 35:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 20 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 20 sts.* (44 sc).
- **Row 36:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (44 sc).
- **Row 37:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 21 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 21 sts.* (46 sc).
- Row 38: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (46 sc).
- **Row 39:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 22 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 22 sts.* (48 sc).
- Row 40: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (48 sc).
- **Row 41:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 23 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 23 sts.* (50 sc).
- Row 42: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (50 sc).
- **Row 43 50:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (50 sc). Rep this row 8 times.

3. Shoulder Shaping:

- **Row 51:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *sc in the next 24 sts, dec, sc in the remaining 24 sts*. (49 sc).
- Row 52: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (49 sc).
- **Row 53:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *sc in the next 24 sts, dec, sc in the remaining 24 sts*. (48 sc).
- **Row 54:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (48 sc).
- Rep Rows 51 54 for a total of 4 times.
- 4. Finishing:
 - Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Front Panel (Make 2):

- 1. Ribbing: Ch 10.
 - **Row 1:** Sc in the second ch from the hook and in each ch across. Turn (10 sc).
 - **Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in the first st and in each st across. Turn (10 sc).
 - Rep Rows 1 and 2 until you have a ribbing section approximately 3 inches (7.5 cm) long.

2. Body:

- **Row 1:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (10 sc).
- **Row 2:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (10 sc).
- **Row 3:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 3 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 3 sts.* (12 sc).
- **Row 4:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (12 sc).
- **Row 5:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 4 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 4 sts.* (14 sc).
- **Row 6:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (14 sc).

- **Row 7:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 5 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 5 sts.* (16 sc).
- **Row 8:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (16 sc).
- **Row 9:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 6 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 6 sts.* (18 sc).
- Row 10: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (18 sc).
- **Row 11:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 7 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 7 sts.* (20 sc).
- **Row 12:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (20 sc).
- **Row 13:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 8 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 8 sts.* (22 sc).
- Row 14: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (22 sc).
- **Row 15:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 9 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 9 sts.* (24 sc).
- **Row 16:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (24 sc).
- **Row 17:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 10 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 10 sts.* (26 sc).
- **Row 18:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (26 sc).
- **Row 19:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 11 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 11 sts.* (28 sc).
- **Row 20:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (28 sc).
- **Row 21:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 12 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 12 sts.* (30 sc).
- Row 22: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (30 sc).
- **Row 23 50:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (30 sc). Rep this row 28 times.

3. Shoulder Shaping:

- **Row 51:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *sc in the next 14 sts, dec, sc in the remaining 14 sts*. (29 sc).
- Row 52: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (29 sc).
- Row 53: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, sc in the next 14 sts, dec, sc in the remaining 14 sts. (28 sc).
- **Row 54:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (28 sc).
- Rep Rows 51 54 for a total of 4 times.
- 4. Finishing:
 - \circ $\;$ Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Sleeves (Make 2):

- 1. Ribbing: Ch 17.
 - **Row 1:** Sc in the second ch from the hook and in each ch across. Turn (16 sc).
 - **Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in the first st and in each st across. Turn (16 sc).
 - Rep Rows 1 and 2 until you have a ribbing section approximately 3 inches (7.5 cm) long.

2. Body:

- **Row 1:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (16 sc).
- Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (16 sc).
- **Row 3:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 7 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 7 sts.* (18 sc).
- **Row 4:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (18 sc).
- **Row 5:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 8 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 8 sts.* (20 sc).
- **Row 6:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (20 sc).
- **Row 7:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 9 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 9 sts.* (22 sc).
- Row 8: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (22 sc).
- **Row 9:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 10 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 10 sts.* (24 sc).
- Row 10: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (24 sc).
- **Row 11:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 11 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 11 sts.* (26 sc).
- Row 12: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (26 sc).
- **Row 13:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 12 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 12 sts.* (28 sc).
- Row 14: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (28 sc).
- **Row 15:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st, *inc in the next st, sc in the next 13 sts, inc in the next st, sc in the remaining 13 sts.* (30 sc).
- Row 16: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (30 sc).
- **Row 17 45:** Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first st and in each st across. (30 sc). Rep this row 29 times.
- 3. Finishing:
 - Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Assembly:

- 1. Seaming: With a tapestry needle and your yarn, seam the shoulder seams of the back and front panels.
- 2. Attach Sleeves: With a tapestry needle and your yarn, attach the sleeves to the armholes of the cardigan.
- 3. Neck Binding: Ch 60.
 - **Row 1:** Sc in the second ch from the hook and in each ch across. Turn (59 sc).
 - \circ **Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in the first st and in each st across. Turn (59 sc).
 - Rep Rows 1 and 2 until you have a ribbing section long enough to go around the neckline of the cardigan.
 - Attach the neck binding to the neckline of the cardigan, using a slip stitch.

Daisies (Make 12):

1. **Center:** Ch 4. Sl st in the first ch to form a ring.

- **Round 1:** Ch 2 (counts as first dc), *dc in the ring, ch 2, rep from * around the ring (8 dc and 8 ch-2 spaces). Sl st in the top of the first dc to join.
- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for attaching.
- 2. Petals:
 - **Round 1:** Make a magic ring. Ch 5, sl st in the first ch to form a ring. Ch 1.
 - **Round 2:** *Sc in the next st, ch 2, skip the next st, sc in the next st, rep from * around the ring. Sl st in the first sc to join.
 - \circ Fasten off.
- 3. Attach Petals: With the long tail from the center of the daisy, attach the petals to the center, using a slip stitch.

Attaching Daisies:

• Using a tapestry needle, attach the daisies to the cardigan in any pattern you prefer.

Finishing Touches:

- **Blocking:** Blocking is optional, but it helps to even out the stitches and give your cardigan a polished look.
- Weave in Ends: Using your tapestry needle, weave in all loose ends.

Color Variations:

- You can use any color or colors for the cardigan and the daisies. You can even choose to use different colors for the petals and the center of the daisies.
- Experiment with different stitch patterns for the body of the cardigan, such as a simple single crochet or a more elaborate stitch pattern.
