I will tell you how to make a crochet bow that you can use to decorate Christmas decorations, gift wrap decorations or other crochet projects you have made.

You can make the bows as big or small as you want.

I will explain all the measurements you need to make for this step by step in the video.

The brand of yarn I will use to make the bows is Gazzal Baby Cotton

crochet hook size 2.50 mm

Now let's start making the bows.

After tying the first knot, let's start by making 32 chains.

The image we get when we fold the 32 chains in 2 shows the size of the bow.

1:19

If you want a smaller bow you can reduce the number of chains

1:24

If you want to make a larger bow you can increase the number of chains

1:30

What is important here is the size we get when we fold it.

1:40

After making 32 chains; Starting from the 2nd chain, let's make a slip stitch until the end of the row.

2:21

When we come to the end of the row; let's make the last slip stitch inside the first knot

2:30

Let's create a ring by making a slip stitch on the top of the first stitch at the beginning of the row without changing the direction of the cord.

After making 1 chain, let's cut the rope leaving some rope

2:55

Now let's make the tails of the bow

2:59

Let's make a chain half as long as the chain we made in the ring.

3:08

I made 32 chains in the ring. Now I will make 17 chains.

3:22

Let's make a slip stitch starting from the 2nd chain until the end of the row.

3:41

When we come to the end of the row; let's make the last slip stitch inside the first knot

3:45

1 chain. Let's cut the rope and hide it between the loops

4:29

Let's give a bow look to these 2 pieces we made.

You can adapt the color combinations you want in the crochet keychain pattern and make it in the size you want.

Diameter of keychain is 5cm

1:07

I will explain step by step in the video all the measurements and numbers required to make a larger or smaller keychain.

I will use Himalaya himagurumi cotton brand threads in making the keychain.

crochet hook size 2.20 mm

If you are ready, let's start making the keychain.

1:39

After tying the first knot, let's start by making 12 chains that are not too tight.

1:50

12 chains indicate the width of the keychain

1:57

If you want to make a larger keychain, you can increase the number of chains by a multiple of 2 (12, 14,16, 18 .... chains)

2:11

Let's make a total of 11 single crochets side by side starting from the 2nd chain until the end of the row.

2:31

1 chain. Let's turn the pattern

2:35

Let's make a total of 11 single crochets side by side starting from the first space

2:59

1 chain. Let's turn the pattern

3:03

The pattern will repeat itself in each row

3:07

Let's make a total of 11 single crochets side by side starting from the first space

3:25

1 chain. Let's turn the pattern

3:28

Let's repeat the operations in the lower row and make a total of 10 rows after the starting chain.

3:33

I made 10 rows

3:37

The most important point to consider when making the keychain square

3:43

We made the initial chain as a multiple of 2 (12 chains)

3:50

and we made 11 single crochets on 12 chains

3:55

You should make a row that is 1 less than the number of single crochets you made in the 1st row (11 single crochets in the 1st row. 10 rows in total)

4:08

example: starting chain 14 / 1st row 13 single crochet / you should make 12 rows in total

4:24

So you should make 1 less row than the number of single crochets.

4:35

At the end of the 10th row, make 1 chain and cut the yarn.

4:59

We must make a total of 2 squares by paying attention to all the rules I have explained here.

5:14

Let's join all the edges of the 2 squares with single crochet

6:27

Let's make 3 single crochets in all corners

8:04

When we reach the end of the row, let's cut the rope and make a secret join.

8:44

Now let's give the gift wrap image on the square with a different color

9:01

Let's fix the rope from the middle point (top of the 5th row)

9:28

Let's continue until the end of the row by making a slip stitch in all the spaces.

10:27

1 chain. Let's cut the rope

10:35

We will repeat the same process upwards

10:46

6. Let's secure the yarn by making a slip stitch at the top of the single crochet

11:59

1 chain. After leaving enough rope to mount the keychain clip, let's cut the rope

12:38

Let's attach the keychain clip

14:03

After attaching the keychain clip, we should do the bow work with the same color.

14:09

I told you how to make this bow in my previous video.

14:16

For the making of the bow, you can click on the 1st video link in the description section of the video.

14:25

You can glue or sew this bow to the middle point.

16:33

This is what I'm going to talk about in this video
