

Crochet Sunflower Keychain – Written Pattern (US Terms)

Materials

- **Yarn:** 5-ply medium thickness yarn, 50% acrylic – 50% cotton
 - Brown (center)
 - Yellow (petals)
 - Green (leaves)
 - **Crochet Hook:** 2.50 mm
 - **Fiberfill stuffing**
 - **Tapestry needle**
 - **Scissors**
 - **Keychain clip**
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Abbreviations

- **ch** = chain
 - **sc** = single crochet
 - **dc** = double crochet
 - **tr** = treble (triple) crochet
 - **hdc** = half double crochet
 - **sl st** = slip stitch
 - **rep** = repeat
 - **st(s)** = stitch(es)
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Sunflower Center (Make 2 identical pieces)

Round 1

Start with a **magic ring**.

Ch 1, make **6 sc** into the ring.

Sl st to the first sc to close the round. (6 sts)

Round 2

Ch 1. Make **2 sc in each stitch around**.

Sl st to the first sc. (12 sts)


Round 3

Ch 1.

2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st — rep around.

(You'll alternate increases and regular scs.)

Sl st to the first sc. (18 sts)

 *Fasten off. Cut the yarn.*

 **Repeat the same steps to make a second circle.**

Joining the Two Circles

Place both circles **together with wrong sides facing inward**.

Attach brown yarn through one pair of opposite loops.
Ch 1, then **sc around**, going through **both layers** to join.

Before fully closing the circle, **stuff with fiberfill**.

Continue sc around to close the remaining gap.
Sl st, then cut the yarn and make a **hidden join**.

Sunflower Petals (Yellow Yarn)

Attach yellow yarn to any sc on the edge of the sunflower.

Petal Repeat (Total: 9 petals)

1. Ch 2
2. In same st: 1 dc, 1 tr
3. Ch 2
4. Sl st into **front loops** of the tr you just made
5. Dc into next st, ch 2, sl st
6. In next st: ch 2, dc, tr
7. Ch 2, sl st into front loops of tr
8. Dc into next st, ch 2, sl st
→ Continue this pattern until you have **9 petals** total.

Sl st to finish.

Ch 1, cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing or adding the keychain clip.

Sunflower Leaf (Make 2)

With green yarn,
Start with a slip knot and **ch 11**.

Working into back bumps of the chain:

- Sl st into 2nd ch
- Sc into next ch
- Hdc into next ch
- Dc into next ch
- Tr into next **2 chains**
- Dc into next ch
- Hdc into next ch
- Sc into next ch

- Sl st into last ch, ch 1, sl st

 **Repeat same pattern** to make the second leaf.


Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for assembly.

Assembling the Leaves

Using a tapestry needle, align the leaves back-to-back (wrong sides facing).
Sew them together **using the back loops** only.

Final Assembly

- Sew the base of the **leaves** to the **keychain ring**.
 - Sew the top of the **sunflower** to the same ring.
 - Use the yellow tail to **attach the sunflower securely**.
 - Fasten the **keychain clip** to the sunflower or ring as you prefer.
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 That's it! You've made a **beautiful crochet sunflower keychain** — perfect as a handmade gift or a cute everyday accessory.
