

## Crochet Wind Spinner Pattern (4 Colors)

**Skill Level:** Beginner

**Pattern Format:** Written (US Terms)

**Project Type:** Hanging wind spinner decoration

**Hook Size:** 2.20 mm

**Yarn:** 5-ply medium weight yarn, 50% cotton / 50% acrylic

**Colors Used:**

- Color A – Mint Green #30C6A3
  - Color B – Coral Red #F65A58
  - Color C – Lime Green #A6CE4A
  - Color D – Bright Orange #F68C1F
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### Materials


- 2.20 mm crochet hook
  - 4 colors of 5-ply cotton/acrylic yarn
  - Scissors
  - Tapestry needle
  - Optional: tassel, beads, wooden ring, or any hanging accessory
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### Pattern Instructions

#### Step 1: Foundation Chain

With **Color A**,

- Make a slip knot.
- Chain **95** (approx. 38 cm). You can increase or decrease this for longer or shorter spinners.  
 *Tip: Keep your chains loose, not too tight.*

#### Step 2: Row 1 (Base Row)

- Starting in the **2nd chain from the hook**, work **1 single crochet (sc)** in each chain across.
- You'll have 94 sc at the end.
- Switch to **Color B**, chain 2, and turn.
- Cut Color A.

#### Step 3: Row 2 (V-Stitch Row)

- Into the **first stitch**, work: *(1 half double crochet (hdc), ch 1, 1 hdc)*
- Repeat in every stitch across: *(hdc, ch 1, hdc)* in the same stitch.
- End with one last V-stitch in the final stitch.
- Chain 1 and fasten off.

- Switch to **Color C**.

#### Step 4: Row 3 (Treble Crochet Rows)

- Join Color C into the **middle of the first V-stitch**.
- Chain 3 (counts as first treble crochet).
- In the same space, make **2 more treble crochets (tr)**.
- In every V-stitch across the row: work **3 tr** into the center of each V.
- End with 3 tr in the last V-stitch.
- Chain 1 and fasten off.

#### Step 5: Row 4 (Finishing Edge)

- Join **Color D** into the top of the first stitch.
- Chain 1, *slip stitch (sl st)* into the next stitch.
- Repeat: (*ch 1, sl st*) across the entire edge.
- Fasten off.



#### Finishing Touches

- Leave a long tail at the end for hanging.
- Tie a secure knot.
- You can add a **tassel** or **bead** at the bottom (as seen in the video), or even crochet your own version.
- Optional: Add a small wooden ring at the top for easier hanging.
