

Pink Rose Bouquet Blanket – Written Crochet Pattern

Materials

- Yarn: Soft cotton in white, green, and pink
 - Hook sizes:
 - 3.00 mm for base and leaves
 - 2.75 mm for rose petals
 - Scissors
 - Yarn needle
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Base Circle

1. Start with a magic ring.
 2. Chain 2. Make 12 double crochets into the ring. (12 stitches total)
 3. Pull the ring tight and slip stitch into the top of the first chain to close the round.
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Round 2

1. Chain 2.
 2. In the same stitch: 1 double crochet.
 3. Chain 1.
 4. In each remaining stitch: work 2 double crochets, chain 1 between each group.
 5. Join with a slip stitch into the first chain. (24 stitches, 12 groups)
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Round 3

1. Chain 2.
 2. In the same stitch: 2 double crochets.
 3. Chain 1.
 4. In each group:
 - 1 double crochet in the first stitch
 - 2 double crochets in the second stitch
 5. Chain 1 between each group.
 6. Join with a slip stitch. (Each group now has 3 double crochets)
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Round 4

1. Chain 2.
 2. In the second stitch of each group: 1 double crochet.
 3. In the third stitch: 2 double crochets.
 4. Continue with:
 - 1 double crochet in each of the first two stitches
 - 2 double crochets in the last stitch
 5. Chain 1 between each group.
 6. Join with a slip stitch. (Groups now have 4 double crochets)
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Round 5

1. Chain 2.
 2. Make 1 double crochet in the second and third stitches.
 3. In the fourth stitch: 2 double crochets.
 4. Each group now has 5 double crochets.
 5. Chain 1 between each group.
 6. Continue around and join with a slip stitch.
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Continue Rounds

- In each round, increase the group by 1 double crochet.
 - Always place the increase (2 double crochets) in the last stitch of the group.
 - Chain 1 between each group.
 - Repeat until your blanket reaches the desired size.
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Leafy Loops

1. Attach green yarn into any stitch from the last round.
 2. Chain 4.
 3. Skip 2 stitches, single crochet into the third.
 4. Repeat: chain 4, skip 2, single crochet.
 5. Be sure to treat chain-1 spaces as stitches too.
 6. Continue this loop pattern all the way around.
 7. Join with a slip stitch. Chain 1 and cut the yarn.
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Petal Loops (Rose Base)

1. Insert hook into the first chain space.
 2. Single crochet.
 3. Chain 4.
 4. Slip stitch into the 2nd chain from the hook.
 5. Chain 3, then single crochet back into the same space.
 6. Move to the next space and repeat.
 7. Complete all triangle-shaped bases around.
 8. Join with a slip stitch and fasten off.
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Crocheting the Roses

1. Attach pink yarn to the single crochet on the left side of any triangle.
 2. Chain 18.
 3. Starting in the 4th chain from the hook:
 - Make 3 double crochets in each chain across.
 4. In the last chain:
 - Make 3 double crochets, chain 3, slip stitch into the same chain.
 5. Roll the strip inward and upward to shape the rose.
 6. Flip the rose. Insert hook into any back stitch and slip stitch to secure.
 7. Slip stitch into the next triangle's single crochet.
 8. Chain 1 and cut yarn.
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Repeating the Roses

- Leave 2 or 3 triangle spaces between each rose.
- Repeat the rose steps around the outer edge.
- Weave in yarn tails on the back for a clean finish.
