

## Easy Crochet Wind Spinner Pattern

**Skill Level:** Beginner

**Pattern Type:** Step-by-step written instructions

**Terminology:** US Crochet Terms

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### Materials

- *Yarn:* 5-ply medium weight yarn (50% acrylic, 50% cotton) in 3 or more colors
- *Crochet Hook:* 2.5 mm for main body, 2.2 mm for hanging chain
- *Optional:* Scissors, yarn needle, tassel

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### Measurements

- 100 chains = approx. 33 cm
- You can make it longer (e.g., 40 cm or 45 cm) by adjusting the number of chains.

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### Instructions

#### ◆ Step 1: Foundation Chain

- With Color A, **ch 100** (or as long as you want your spinner).
- **Turn** your work.

#### ◆ Step 2: Row 1 – Single Crochet Base

- Starting from the 2nd chain from the hook, **sc** into each chain across.
- When you reach the end, **ch 1**, fasten off.
- Do **not** turn. We'll start from the beginning again.

#### ◆ Step 3: Row 2 – Increasing with Double Crochet

- Join Color A at the beginning of Row 1.
- Work **2 dc** in **each sc** across the row.
- At the end, **ch 1**, fasten off.

#### ◆ Step 4: Row 3 – Granny Stitch Vibes

- Join Color B at the beginning.
- Work **3 dc** into the first stitch,
- Then repeat: (*ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 3 dc into next stitch*) until the end.
- At the end, finish with **2 dc** in the last stitch.
- **Ch 1**, fasten off.

#### ◆ Step 5: Row 4 – Fan Stitch Detail

- Join Color C.

- Start with **2 sc side by side** into the first 2 stitches.
- In each **ch-1 space**, work:  
**(hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc)**
- After each fan, place **1 sc** on the 2nd dc of the previous 3-dc group.
- Repeat across.
- End with **2 sc side by side**.
- **Ch 1**, fasten off.

#### ◆ Step 6: Row 5 – Final Shaping Row

- Join Color D.
- Work **sc** in each stitch across.
- When you reach the **top of each tr** stitch (from the fans), place **2 sc** instead of 1.
- This adds the twist to your spinner!
- **Ch 1**, fasten off. Weave in ends.

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#### 🔗 Hanging Chain

- Switch to a **2.2 mm** hook.
- Join yarn to the **first sc space from Row 1**.
- **Ch 35** (or desired length).
- Slip stitch back into the same point to form a loop.
- Fasten off, weave in the end.

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#### 🎀 Tassel (Optional)

- Create a tassel using 2 of your yarn colors.
- Attach the tassel to the **last sc space from Row 1** (bottom end).
- Trim andneaten the tassel.

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#### 🖼️ Finishing Touch

- Twist the piece gently around its own axis to form a spinner shape.
- Hang it on your **balcony, garden, or tree** to enjoy the beautiful spiral effect in the wind!
