

Easy Crochet Christmas Tree Ornament

Skill Level: Beginner

Technique: Granny Square + Popcorn Stitch

Estimated Time: 15 minutes

Size: ~8 cm (3 in) tall

Materials:

- 5-ply cotton-acrylic yarn in **green, red, white, and brown**
- 2.5 mm crochet hook (US B-1)
- Scissors
- Tapestry (yarn) needle

 *Tip: You can use pure cotton for a crisp look, or acrylic yarn for a softer finish.*

Green Base – Round 1

With green yarn:

- 1 Make a **magic ring**.
- 2 **Ch 2** (counts as first dc).
- 3 Work **12 dc into the ring**.
- 4 Pull ring tight and **join with a sl st** to the top of beginning ch-2. (12 sts)
- 5 **Ch 1, cut yarn.** Fasten off.

 *Tip: Keep your stitches loose so the circle lays flat.*

Red Popcorn Round – Round 2

Switch to red yarn.

- 1 Join red yarn to any stitch.
- 2 **Ch 3, make 3 dc in same stitch.**
- 3 **Remove your hook**, insert it into the top of the ch-3, grab the loop, and pull through — forms one **popcorn stitch**.
- 4 **Sl st into next stitch**, then make another **4-dc popcorn**.
- 5 Repeat steps around the circle → **12 popcorns total**.
- 6 **Sl st to first popcorn** to close the round.
- 7 **Ch 1, cut yarn**, and fasten off.

 *Tip: Popcorn stitches give a lovely 3D wreath effect.*

Forming the Square – Round 3

Switch back to green yarn.

- 1 Attach yarn to any stitch.
- 2 **Ch 2 (counts as first dc).**

- 3 In same st: **(1 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)** — this forms your **first corner**.
- 4 Next st: 1 dc.
- 5 Next st: 1 hdc.
- 6 Next st: 1 sc.
- 7 Next st: 1 hdc, then 1 dc.
- 8 In next st: **(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)** — second corner.
- 9 Continue the same pattern around for all **four corners**.
- 10 At last corner, finish with **dc, hdc, sc, hdc, dc**.
- 11 Join with **sl st** to top of first ch-2.

 *Tip: The different stitch heights help transform your circle into a neat square.*

Border Round – Round 4

- 1 **Ch 2, 1 dc** in next st.
- 2 In corner space: **(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)**.
- 3 Work **1 dc in each stitch** along the side until you reach next corner.
- 4 Repeat the corner pattern **(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)** on each corner.
- 5 Continue around.
- 6 At end, **cut yarn leaving a long tail**, and join with an **invisible join**.
- 7 Weave the tail through the back stitches to a nearby corner.

 *Tip: This border gives the tree more structure for folding.*

Wreath & Bow Decoration

With white yarn:

- 1 Thread your **tapestry needle**.
- 2 Stitch small **zigzags** over the red popcorn stitches to form a snowy wreath look.

For the bow:

- 1 Chain **30** (or any length you prefer).
- 2 Cut yarn leaving a tail, shape chain into a **small bow**.
- 3 Use the tail to **attach the bow** at the top of your square or in a corner gap.

 *Tip: Add tiny beads or sequins for sparkle!*

Shaping the Tree

- 1 Fold the **square in half diagonally** (corner with bow on top).
- 2 Use the yarn tail to **sew down one side**, matching stitches across.
- 3 Then **fold the bottom point upward** slightly to form the tree shape.
- 4 **Sew along the edge** again to secure.

Tree Trunk

With brown yarn:

- 1** Insert hook through **front and back corners** at the bottom.
- 2** Pull up loop and secure yarn.
- 3** **Ch 3.**
- 4** In same space: **3 treble crochets (tr).**
- 5** **Ch 3, sl st** into same space.
- 6** **Ch 1, cut yarn,** fasten off.

 **Finishing Touch**

Add a **hanging loop** at the top using matching color yarn (green or white).

Weave in all ends securely.
