



# Crochet Book Keychain Pattern

**Skill Level:** Beginner

**Style:** Flat rectangle + inner panel

**Terminology:** US Terms

---



## Materials

- Cotton yarn – 2 colors
  - 2.5 mm crochet hook
  - Yarn needle (tapestry needle)
  - Scissors
  - Keychain clasp
  - Strong craft glue
- 



## Finished Size

Mini rectangular “book” shape

(Size may vary slightly depending on yarn tension.)

## Stitches Used (US Terms)

- ch – chain
  - sc – single crochet
  - sl st – slip stitch
  - FLO – front loop only
  - BLO – back loop only
- 



## PART 1: OUTER BOOK COVER

### Foundation

Ch 13 (not too tight).

---

### Row 1

Sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Sc across. (12 sc)

You should have 12 stitches.

---

## Row 2

Ch 1, turn.  
Sc across. (12 sc)

---

## Rows 3–8

Repeat Row 2.

You will have **8 rows total**.

Keep edges straight and tension even.

---

## Row 9 – Texture Row

Ch 1, turn.  
Sc across in **front loops only (FLO)**. (12 sc)

---

## Row 10 – Texture Row

Ch 1, turn.  
Sc across in **back loops only (BLO)**. (12 sc)

This creates the “book spine” detail.

---

## Rows 11–18

Ch 1, turn.  
Sc across. (12 sc)

Repeat until you have **18 rows total**.

You now have a tall rectangle.

---



## BORDER ROUND

After Row 18:

Ch 1.

Work sc evenly around the entire rectangle:

- 1 sc in each row-end along the side
- 12 sc across bottom
- 1 sc in each row-end on opposite side
- 12 sc across top

At each corner:

Ch 1 to help shape the corner.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for the clasp.

---



## FINISHING THE OUTER COVER

- Make an invisible join into first stitch.
- Weave in loose ends.
- Find the exact center of the top edge.
- Use the long tail to bring yarn to the top center (this will hold the clasp later).

Set aside.

---



## PART 2: INNER BOOK PANEL

Switch to second color.

---

### Foundation

Ch 16.

---

### Row 1

Sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Sc across. (15 sc)

---

### Rows 2–10

Ch 1, turn.

Sc across. (15 sc)

Repeat until you have **10 rows total**.

---

## Border Round

Sc evenly around.

At each corner:  
Ch 1.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

---



## ASSEMBLY

1. Place white inner panel centered on outer cover.
  2. Make sure wrong sides face inward.
  3. Leave a small border visible on top and bottom.
  4. Apply glue inside only.
  5. Fold in half and press firmly.
  6. Let dry.
- 



## ATTACH KEYCHAIN CLASP

Use the long yarn tail:

- Attach clasp securely at the top center.
  - Knot firmly.
  - Hide ends on back side.
- 



## Optional Customization

Add:

- Tiny buttons
  - Small charms
  - Embroidery details
  - Mini star or heart applique
- 



## Final Result

A tiny crochet book keychain —  
perfect for gifts, book lovers, teachers, or craft fairs.
