

Written Crochet Pattern — Crochet Tulip Bouquet

Finished Project

A beginner-friendly **crochet tulip bouquet**: 1 tulip body + 2 leaves (repeat to build a fuller bouquet).

Materials & Tools (as in transcript)

- **Medium weight yarn (worsted)**: 50% cotton / 50% acrylic (main tulip color + green)
- **2.20 mm crochet hook (US B/1)**
- **Wooden skewer** (stem)
- **Tapestry/yarn needle**
- **Polyester fiberfill**
- **Copper wire 5 mm** (for leaf shaping)
- Optional: **hot glue** (assembly)

Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- st(s) = stitch(es)

Note (matches video method): **ch-1 does not count as a stitch** in these rounds. Join to the **first sc**.

Part 1 — Tulip Body (Rounds 1–22)

Round 1

Magic ring, **ch 1, 8 sc** into ring. Pull tail tight. **Join** with **sl st** to first sc. **(8 sts)**

Round 2

ch 1, 2 sc in each st around. Join. **(16 sts)**

Round 3

ch 1, (2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st) around. Join. **(24 sts)**

Round 4

ch 1, (2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts) around. Join. **(32 sts)**

Round 5

ch 1, (2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts) around. Join. **(40 sts)**

Rounds 6–22

ch 1, **1 sc in each st around**. Join at end of each round. (**40 sts each round**)

- Work until you have **22 rounds total from the magic ring**.

Finish

Join, **ch 1**, leave a **long tail for sewing/closing**, cut yarn, secure.

Part 2 — Leaf (Make 2)

Foundation

With green yarn: slip knot, **ch 30**

(*For larger leaves, increase starting chains.*)

Row 1 (working into chains)

- **sc in 2nd ch** from hook, sc in next ch
- **2 hdc** in next 2 chains (one each)
- **20 hdc** (one in each of next 20 chains)
- **2 hdc** (one in each of next 2 chains)
- **2 sc** (one in each of next 2 chains)
- In last chain: **3 sc in same chain** (turn corner)

Row 1 (other side of foundation)

- sc in next **2** chains
- hdc in next **2** chains
- hdc in next **2** chains (same idea as before)
- **20 dc** across (one in each of next 20 chains)
- **2 hdc** (next 2)
- **1 sc** (next 1)
- In the first corner/starting space: work 2 sc to turn.
 - (You'll have 3 sc in this corner in total.)

Edge Round (single crochet clean-up)

Work **sc evenly around the entire edge** to “clean it up.”

Add wire while edging (as shown)

- Use a thin, bendable wire.
- sl st into the **first chain area**, securing the wire at the same time.
- **ch 1**, then sc along the top edge **while guiding the wire through the stitches**.
- At the corner where you made 3 sc, find the middle (2nd) sc.
Work 3 sc into that middle stitch to round the corner smoothly.
- Continue sc around, guiding wire.
- At the very last stitch, **2 sc in same st** for a neat finish.

- Finish with **sl st to the top of the first chain.**

Finish leaf

ch 1, cut yarn, fasten off.

Leaf size (from transcript): ~ 11 cm long and 2.5 cm wide.

Part 3 — Stem + Assembly (Tulip Bouquet)

1. Take the **wooden skewer**.
2. Insert it **through the magic ring opening** at the base of the tulip.
3. Add a little **hot glue** inside (optional but used in video).
4. Stuff the top with **polyester fiberfill** to shape the tulip.
5. Attach leaves **wherever you like**, then gently **bend/pose** them using the wire.
