

Crochet Chicken Coaster – Written Pattern

Beginner Friendly Crochet Pattern

A cute and fun crochet chicken coaster that's perfect for beginners. This quick project creates a round coaster with a decorative scalloped edge and a charming chicken face.

Finished Size

Approx. **4 inches (10 cm) diameter**

Materials

- Medium weight cotton yarn
(example: Himalaya Himagurumi Cotton Yarn)
 - Crochet hook **2.20 mm**
 - Red yarn (comb)
 - Yellow yarn (beak)
 - Googly eye
 - Tapestry needle
 - Craft glue (for the eye)

Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
 - sl st = slip stitch
 - sc = single crochet
 - hdc = half double crochet
 - dc = double crochet
 - tr = treble crochet
 - st = stitch
 - inc = increase
-

Pattern Notes

- This pattern is **worked in the round**.
 - **Ch 3 at the beginning of each round counts as a double crochet.**
 - Join each round with a **slip stitch**.
 - Weave in all yarn ends on the back of the work.

Base Chicken Coaster

Use **main color yarn**.

Round 1 – Magic Ring

Make a **magic ring**.

Ch 3 (counts as first dc).

Work **14 dc into the magic ring**.

Pull the yarn tail to close the ring.

Sl st to the top of the starting ch 3.

Total: 15 dc

Round 2 – Increase Round

Ch 3 (counts as first dc).

Dc in the same stitch.

Work **2 dc in each stitch around**.

Sl st to the top of the starting ch 3.

Total: 30 dc

Round 3 – Increase Round

Ch 3 (counts as first dc).

Dc in same stitch.

Repeat around:

2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next stitch

Sl st to the top of the starting ch 3.

Total: 45 dc

Round 4 – Increase Round

Ch 3 (counts as first dc).

Dc in same stitch.

Repeat around:

2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in each of the next 2 stitches

Continue until the end of the round.

You should have **3 stitches remaining**.

Finish the round with:

2 sc

Sl st to join.

Total: 56 stitches

Round 5 – Shell Edge

Ch 3 and **turn the work**.

In the **third stitch**, work:

6 dc

Skip 2 stitches.

Sc in next stitch.

Repeat around:

Skip 2 stitches

6 dc in next stitch

Skip 2 stitches

sc in next stitch

Continue until the end.

You should create **10 shell groups**.

Chicken Head

Skip 2 stitches.

Make **5 sc in a row**.

Skip 2 stitches.

Into the next space work:

10 treble crochets

(This forms the chicken's head.)

Sl st to join.

Ch 1 and cut yarn.

Weave in the ends on the back.

Chicken Comb (Red Yarn)

Join red yarn with a sl st into the **first of the 5 single crochets**.

Skip 1 stitch.

Make **4 dc in next stitch**.

Skip 1 stitch.

Sl st in next stitch.

Ch 1 and cut yarn.

Weave in the ends.

Upper Comb

Join red yarn into the **slip stitch space**.

Ch 3.

Dc in same space.

Ch 3.

Sl st in same space (creates a small point).

Sc in next stitch.

Sl st in next stitch.

Repeat the same steps once more to form the comb.

Ch 1 and cut yarn.

Weave in ends.

Chicken Beak (Yellow Yarn)

Join yellow yarn to the **first treble crochet of the head**.

Ch 3.

Work **2 hdc together side by side**.

Pull yarn and close loops together.

Ch 3.

Sl st in the next treble crochet.

Ch 1 and cut yarn.

Weave in the ends.

Eyes

Attach a **googly eye** above the beak using craft glue.

Finishing

- Weave in all loose yarn ends.
- Make sure the coaster lies flat.
- Light blocking is optional.

Your **Crochet Chicken Coaster** is now finished!

If you enjoyed making this project, try experimenting with different yarn colors or even making a larger version as a **placemat**.
