

Crochet Daisy Snap Hair Clip – Written Pattern

Beginner-Friendly Step-by-Step Tutorial


Materials

- Cotton yarn (3 colors):
 - Green (base)
 - Yellow (center)
 - White / Pink (petals)
 - Snap hair clip: **6 cm (≈ 2.4 inches)**
 - Crochet hooks:
 - **2.0 mm**
 - **1.75 mm** (optional for tighter stitches)
 - Yarn needle
 - Scissors
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Abbreviations (US Terms)


- ch = chain
 - sc = single crochet
 - dc = double crochet
 - hdc = half double crochet
 - sl st = slip stitch
 - MR = magic ring (adjustable loop)
 - st = stitch
 - sp = space
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PART 1: Covering the Snap Hair Clip (Green Base)

 We'll start by wrapping and covering the metal clip.

Step 1: Start

- Place the clip in front of you
- Attach yarn near one side of the clip

 Tip: Keep the open side of the clip facing right

Step 2: First stitches

- Make **1 sc**
 - Then **ch 4**
-

Step 3: Work across

- Move to the opposite opening
- Make **20 sc across the top**

👉 Don't worry if your count is slightly different (depends on yarn thickness and clip size)

Step 4: Shape the curve

- Continue with **sc around the curved end**
- Add **4 extra sc** in the curve

👉 This helps the clip keep a nice rounded shape

Step 5: Other side

- Work **20 sc** along the other side
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Step 6: Close the round

- **sl st into the first st**

👉 Round complete ✓

🌿 Edge Detail Round

Step 7:

- Into chain space → **2 sc**
 - Behind clip → **3 hdc**
 - Into next space → **2 sc**
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Step 8:

- **sl st to join**
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Step 9: Decorative edge

Repeat around:

- **ch 1**

- sl st

👉 Repeat this small pattern all the way around

Step 10: Finish base

- ch 1
 - Cut yarn (leave tail)
 - Make an **invisible join**
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🌸 PART 2: Daisy Center (Yellow)

Step 1: Magic Ring

- Make a **magic ring (adjustable loop)**

👉 This lets you tighten the center later

Step 2:

- ch 4
 - 1 dc into ring
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Step 3:

Repeat until:

- total **10 dc**
 - with **ch 1 between each**
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Step 4:

- sl st into 3rd chain
 - close the round
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Step 5:

- ch 1
 - cut yarn
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🌸 PART 3: Petals (White / Pink)

Step 1:

- Attach yarn into any chain space

- ch 2
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Step 2: First petal (popcorn)

- 4 dc into same space
 - sl st into first dc → forms popcorn
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Step 3:

- ch 2
 - sl st into next space
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Step 4:

Repeat around:

👉 (ch 2 → popcorn → ch 2 → sl st)

Step 5:

- After last petal:
 - ch 2
 - sl st into first space
-

Step 6:

- ch 1
- cut yarn

👉 Flower complete ✓

PART 4: Assembly

Step 1:

- Place flower on top of clip

Step 2:

- Sew it securely using yarn needle

👉 Tip: Stitch through center multiple times for stability

Final Result

You now have a beautiful:

Crochet Daisy Snap Hair Clip

Beginner Tips

- If stitches feel tight → use bigger hook
 - If clip looks loose → use smaller hook
 - Always adjust stitch count based on clip size
 - Practice popcorn stitch slowly at first
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Custom Ideas

- Make pairs (great for selling 💰)
 - Try pastel color combos
 - Use brighter centers for contrast
